What defines a lingering hemlock

- ✓ More than 80% of surrounding trees are dead or dying
- ✓ Growing in a forested or natural area
- ✓ Greater than 4 inches in diameter at breast height
- ✓ Crown is healthier than those of surrounding hemlocks

WHO: Anyone who has been trained*

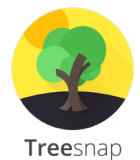
WHAT: Lingerin hemlocks are hemlocks that match the description to the left and therefore may possess some level of resistance to hemlock woolly adelgid (HWA)

WHERE: Anywhere HWA has led to significant hemlock mortality

WHEN: NOW!

WHY: Researchers need to locate and study these trees that are declining more slowly to learn more about possible mechanisms of genetic resistance that can be bolstered through selective hemlock breeding
